

Award of RAFLAA Trophy 2018 to Sergeant Milward, No. 1 Radio School RAF Cosford

The citation for the trophy reads:

“Sgt Milward has made an immense contribution in both Quality and Quantity to junior officers and Trade Group 4 tradesmen Phase 2 training, actively and continuously made improvements and has been instrumental in the redevelopment of EOFT and development of the new 4400 courseware. At the same time has also delivered a significant amount of training to officers and airmen at a time when he was the sole SNCO within EOFT.
